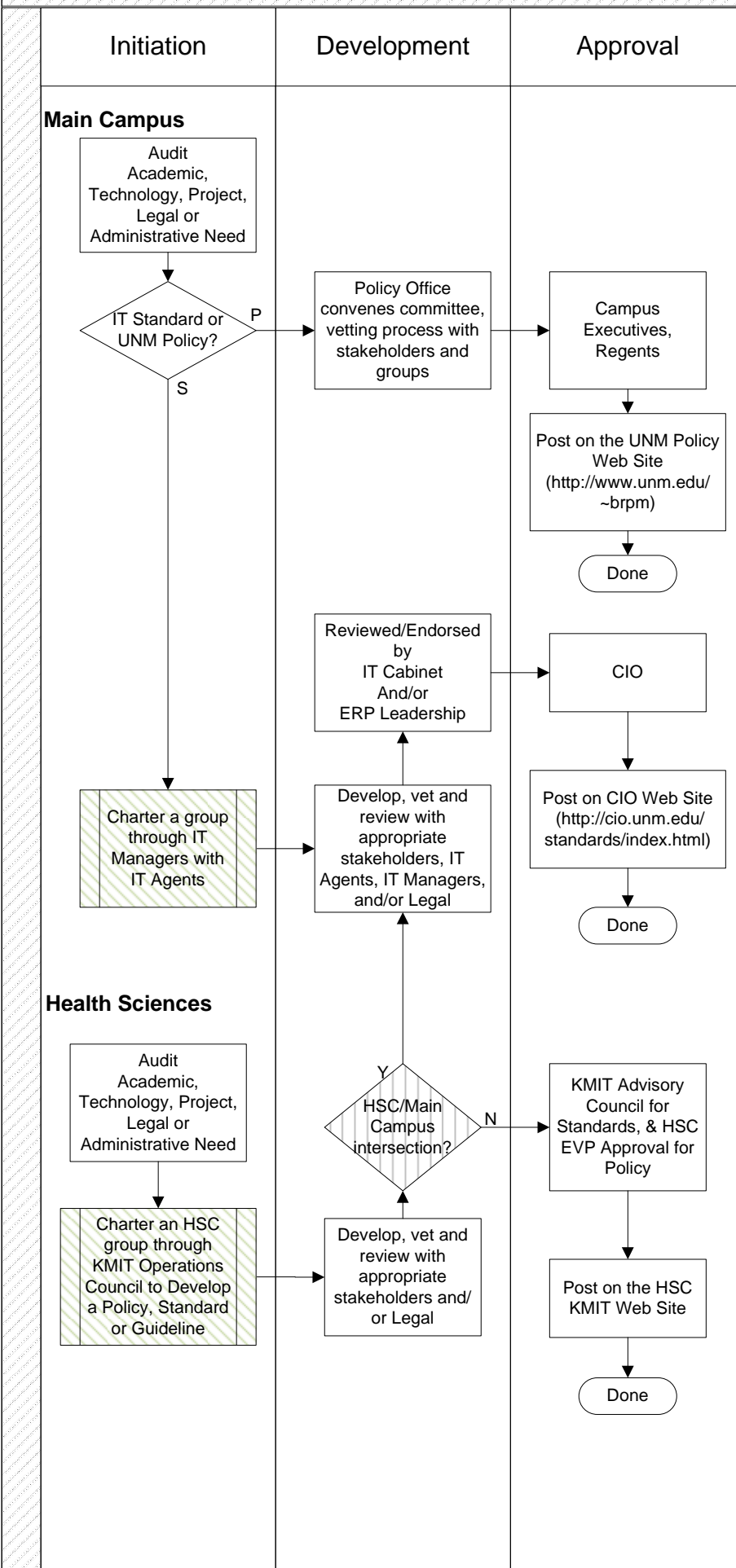

## Chartering Process

Charter includes:

- Name of Task Force
- Relation to the IT Strategic Planning
- Team Members
- Vision
- Mission/Purpose
- Measure of Success
- Tasks & Deliverables
- Roles & Responsibilities
- Ground Rules
- Meetings
- Boundaries, Scope & Authority
- Reporting Status
- Target / Desired Completion Date

## HSC / Main Campus Intersection

An HSC Policy, Standard or Guideline impacts Main Campus IT if it touches:

- The Voice, Video or Data Network
- Enterprise Applications
- Enterprise IT Services
- Directory Services
- Purchasing

Examples of exclusion from Main Campus impact would be HSC-exclusive, discipline-specific or departmental stand-alone applications
